ACP Sponsored Histopathology Course

Pilsen, Czech Republic 2008

We have the pleasure to announce Courses in Pathology at a multihead microscope given by Pilsen pathologists, which will take place at the Bioptical Laboratory in Pilsen, Czech Republic **from Friday, January 31 st , to Sunday, February 3 rd , 2008**. The courses will be organized at multihead OLYMPUS microscope. As the multihead microscope has altogether 22 seats, there are only 21 seats for participants. The course will start on Friday, Jan 31 st 2008 at 9 AM.

Within these 3 days the participants will take 6 courses lasting approximately 3 to 4 hours each (2 courses per day). Slides of many hundreds of interesting cases will be shown. **The topics of the courses are as follows: Pathology of the Head and Neck (Skálová), Pathology of the Skin (Kazakov), Pathology of the Breast (Kinkor), Pathology of the Urogenital Tract (Hes), and two courses of Selected Problems in Surgical Pathology (Michal)** . All courses will be held in English.

For interested participants we are planning a short trip to Prague including a dinner in a Prague restaurant on the Royal Road. The course will end on Sunday, Feb 3 rd 2008 in the evening.

This sponsored course is open to SpRs in histopathology and training in UK. All course and maintenance costs will be met by ACP (preference will be given to ACP trainee members.) Low cost flights to Prague airport will also be paid (up to £100.)

The accommodation provided is for 4 nights (Hotel Hazuka in Pilsen), three dinners (including the one dinner in Prague with transfer to Prague and back), and transfer to and from the airport in Prague.
